The degree difference of interjection to constrain the interpretation of the utterance listener : In the case of restoring implicature

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The purpose of this study is to consider the involvement of interjection for the restoration of the implicit meaning in terms of an estimate of the listener for the ostensive intention of utterance on communication. Between the audiovisual video on which the person was talking towards the audience along with the line of sight and the same one except such gaze, we examined whether any differences would occur in utterance interpretation of the audience by psycholinguistic technique.

As the results, shortening the time required for restoration of the implicit meaning occurred, depending on the estimate of the listener for the ostensive intention of utterance with the interjection. And also, it was suggested that the time required for it was not a uniform because of the type of interjection itself. However, the variety of the process of the restoration did not influence the implicature as a result of restoration.
